Another significant winter storm is expected to impact our service territory. Wednesday, December 21st through Friday, December 23rd. Additional snow and strong winds could lead to power outages. Prepare by doing the following:

- Have plenty of water and food (for people, pets, and livestock) Get medications refilled
- Charge cell phones
- Fill your car with gas and get gas for generators
- Gather blankets and warm clothes
- Have flashlights, batteries, candles, lanterns ready
