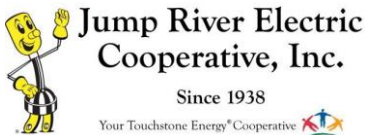

- Explanation of Award:** Jump River Electric Cooperative Scholarship is open to graduating **home-schooled** high school students and will be awarded as follows:
- Two Scholarships to be awarded to graduating homeschooled students from each of the following areas:**
Hayward, Ladysmith, and the greater Jump River area.
- Application Deadline:** An application form should be completed and returned to Jump River Electric Cooperative, PO Box 99, Ladysmith WI 54848, by April 15 of each year.
- Selection Criteria:** The applicant must:
1. Receive a homeschool diploma.
 2. Display average or above average academic records.
 3. Family income should not be a deciding factor.
 4. Display potential to successfully continue achievement in a post-secondary public or private college, university, junior college, or vocational school program, which will lead to an associate degree or one-year diploma.
 5. Student's parents or legal guardian must be an active member of JREC and currently receive electric service.
 6. Priority will be given to any applicant who has participated in the Youth Leadership Congress, or any youth program offered by JREC.
- Selection Committee:** Recipients will be selected by a committee comprised from the Wisconsin Electric Cooperative Association-Federated Youth Foundation.
1. None of these should be a relative of an applicant.
 2. This committee shall select two homeschool scholarship recipients from the applications submitted to Jump River Electric Cooperative, Inc., PO Box 99, Ladysmith, WI 54848 for each of the following areas: Hayward, Ladysmith, and the greater Jump River area.
- Monetary Disbursement:** The recipient will receive funds when proof of enrollment and acceptance is furnished to JREC, **within one year of receiving their homeschool diploma.**
- Alternate Selection:** If a recipient fails to comply with selection criteria, a complying alternate may be selected.
