Members are able to cast their vote one of three ways. ANNUAL MEETING 2023

The 85th annual meeting is set for April 29, 2023 and is to be held in the Ladysmith Headquarters warehouse, along Highway 27. Members will have the opportunity to vote on district 3, 4, and 9 director elections and on two proposed bylaw amendments. Members can vote one of three ways:

1 ABSENTEE BALLOT



An absentee ballot will be included in the April issue of the *Wisconsin Energy Cooperative News* and mailed to each active member at the end of March. Be sure to follow the mailing instructions. Ballots will need to be received at our offices on or before 4 p.m. on April 28 to be counted.

2 ELECTRONIC BALLOT



Members can cast a web ballot online through SmartHub (an online account portal). You will need to follow the instructions on the next page to use this option. Online voting will open on March 31 and close April 27 at 4 p.m.

3 IN PERSON AT THE ANNUAL MEETING



Members who attend the annual meeting on April 29 and have not cast a ballot prior to the meeting will receive a Meeting-Day ballot. Ballots can be obtained from the person at the registration table.
