COOPERATIVE MEMBERS GATHER FOR THE 88TH ANNUAL MEETING



Back in 1938, innovations like the ballpoint pen were just beginning to change everyday life. A gallon of gas cost about a dime and many rural homes still didn't have electricity. At the same time, Jump River Electric Cooperative was formed, bringing power, opportunity, and connection.

Fast forward 88 years, and electricity powers more than our homes. It supports businesses, advanced technology, and everyday life in ways those early members could only imagine. Reflecting this year's theme, *Together, We're Building for Tomorrow*, members who attended the 88th Annual Meeting received updates on how ongoing changes within the electric utility industry are directly impacting them today—and how those efforts are shaping the future of their cooperative.

Board Chair Bill van Doorn opened the meeting by highlighting notable achievements in 2025, focusing on the value the co-op has brought to its members and community through the return of \$524,273 in capital credits, \$331,550 in scholarships since 1984, and the Community Cents program is once again awarding grants.

General Manager & CEO Kurt Harris reported that since 2022, the cooperative has seen continued improvement in its equity-to-assets ratio as a result of cost-cutting and prudent decision making. He shared how increasing energy demand is influencing costs and how members can help stabilize rates by lowering their peak demand. He reviewed key areas of the business and how they have evolved over the past five years, including energy sales, outages, and ongoing reliability initiatives that should reduce the potential impact of outages.

Harris also reviewed recent Power Cost Adjustments, noting that the cooperative does absorb these additional charges rather than passing them on to members whenever possible. Members received updates on two solar projects that will help provide clean energy at a long-term fixed price, helping to reduce future purchased power expenses and support rate stability. Harris finished his report by addressing data centers and how JREC is carefully evaluating these large loads to ensure they benefit the cooperative while protecting existing members.

Attendees also heard from Matt Brandrup, President & CEO of Rural Electric Supply Cooperative, JREC's wholesale supplier of high-voltage materials. Brandrup provided an update on industry conditions, including previous supply chain challenges, the impact of inflation on product costs, and infrastructure investments that will benefit our members. He also presented a patronage capital check to Board Chair van Doorn and General Manager/CEO Harris.

Thank you to all the members who helped make this meeting a success. From Izzy Clark's delicious cookies that were enjoyed before the meeting, to Charmaine Riddle's performance of the National Anthem to start the meeting, the ballot tellers who counted the votes, and all members who attended the meeting—your involvement makes a difference.

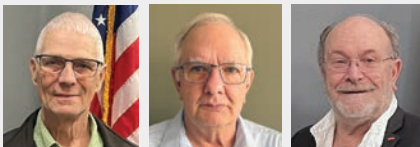
ANNUAL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Board of Director Election

No ballots were issued for the director elections as all three incumbent directors ran unopposed. Instead, the election was conducted at the annual meeting by unanimous consent. The following directors were re-elected to serve a three-year term: District 3, Joe Lorence of Sheldon; District 4, Jay Waeltz of Ladysmith; and District 9, Sandy Schara of Hayward.

Bylaw Amendment Not Adopted

The member proposed bylaw amendment to eliminate director term limits was not adopted. Balloting results were 108 members voted in favor and 458 were opposed.

EVERGREEN PROGRAM

Evergreen is a simple, voluntary way for members to make a lasting impact by growing renewable energy for generations to come. Your cooperative has offered the program since the late 1990s. Today, member participation continues to drive the expansion of renewable energy beyond what the state requires.

What does it cost?

It's affordable and flexible. Members can purchase 100 kilowatt-hour (kWh) blocks for just \$0.50 per block.

What does that mean for you?

In addition to your normal monthly electric bill, you pay a small additional charge each month to offset the additional cost it takes to support renewable energy. For example, if your home uses 1,000 kWh per month, you could cover the cost to power your entire home with green energy for just \$5 more per month. (10 blocks at \$0.50). Even a few blocks make an impact.

How do I sign up?

Visit jrec.com/evergreen-program and complete the signup form.

Give it a try and join those members who are currently supporting the purchase of 2,674 blocks of renewable energy. Feel free to start with one block and increase anytime.

What you need to know about residential solar

Are you considering installing a solar system yourself? If so, there are several factors to keep in mind before making this decision. Selecting a professional installer, the right system, and the best payment method are all crucial considerations. You can find information at jrec.com/distributed-energy that can help walk you through questions you may have and questions you should ask of any solar vendor.

You can find your home's energy use from the past year through SmartHub or by contacting our office. Keep in mind that your energy use may change over time due to a variety of factors. Improving your home's energy efficiency can help reduce the size of the solar array you may need and save you money whether or not you choose to install solar. Energy Sense rebates are available for many energy efficiency upgrades, as well as renewable energy projects.

Jump River Electric does need to know if you add a solar system to your residence, regardless of it being connected to the grid. However, if you are planning to take advantage of net-metering, contact us early on so we can help you navigate through the interconnection process.

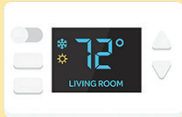

OUTAGE COMMUNICATION JUST GOT BETTER

With Outage Alert Notifications

SmartHub gives members convenient access to account information and alert options. As of June 1, members with a SmartHub account will automatically be enrolled into outage alert notifications. This feature allows us to communicate directly with members affected by an outage, through alerts sent by text or email.

When an outage occurs, this alert will include the estimated time of restoration. While we strive to provide the most accurate information possible, restoration times are estimates based on predictive models. Factors such as weather conditions, outage complexity, and the number of outages can all affect how safely and quickly power is restored. As a result, the predicted restoration times may change.

MEETING LOCAL NEEDS THROUGH SHARED SUPPORT

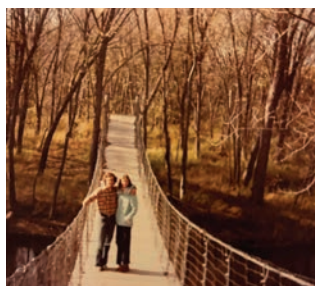
For the past six years, your cooperative has participated in the Sharing Success grant program offered by CoBank, a national cooperative bank that matches charitable contributions made by its co-op members. JREC can donate to four organizations each year through this program. JREC's portion of the donation comes from the Federated Youth Foundation, which is funded by unclaimed capital credits.

The Trail's End Camp (TEC), located northeast of Bruce, Wis. along the Chippewa River, is one of the recipients to benefit from this shared support, receiving a total donation of \$5,000. This money will help cover some of the cost of replacing their aging privy facilities, fondly being called the Privy Project. These structures are well past their useful life and in great need of being replaced. This upgrade means cleaner facilities, safer conditions, improved sanitation, and compliance with modern health and environmental standards.

TEC Coordinator Charmaine Riddle said, "Support like this shows just how much our community values Trail's End Camp and the experiences it provides."

A little history

This camp has long been a place where local youth come together to learn, grow, and enjoy the outdoors. In fact, it was in 1926 that Rusk County purchased the land that now houses this camp. In 1933, Claude Ebling had a plan for Trail's End Camp, and in August of that year, he took his plan to the Rusk County Commissioner for approval. It was granted and the land was deeded to a special 4-H committee for the use of 4-H and FFA youth activities. The beginning of summer camp activities began in 1934 with nearly 600 people attending the first official club outing. Included on this page are some photos of youth groups enjoying this camp over the many years it's been in existence.

CONSTRUCTION CORNER

We are continuing to work on a project in the Sheldon/Holcombe area, upgrading a two-phase overhead line to three-phase power. Next, we will begin a project in the Weyerhaeuser area, where approximately two miles of overhead lines will be converted to underground service.

In the Hayward area, we are upgrading .9 miles of single-phase overhead line to a three-phase underground service in the Spider Lake township. We are also completing two projects that convert single-phase overhead power lines to underground services.

These upgrades strengthen our infrastructure and are designed to improve power quality, enhance reliability, and provide better overall service to our members.
